FIRST CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

AIM

The Association of Vietnamese Scientists and Experts (AVSE) and the Paris Dauphine University - Ph.D. and Ph.D. candidate association (ADDD) join forces to organize the Second AVSE Annual Doctoral Workshop (JRD 2013). This workshop will be organized on Wednesday and Thursday the 30th-31th of October 2013. Open to all Ph.D. students (Vietnamese in particular) from all disciplines, who currently pursue a doctoral program in Europe (France, Italy, Belgium, Spain, Switzerland, Germany, UK...), the JRD 2013 aims to give the participants the opportunity to: (i) meet each other; (ii) exchange research ideas and experiences; (iii) present their ongoing research projects and/or research papers; (iv) get comments from senior researchers and fellow students.

TOPICS

Doctoral students working on all areas of science are welcome and cordially invited to submit an abstract on their Ph.D. research for presentations (oral or/and poster) at the workshop. Examples of several areas include:

- Applied sciences: civil engineering, information and communication technologies, biology, electrical engineering, nuclear energy,...
- Natural sciences: mathematics, physics, chemistry,...
- Social and human sciences: economics, management (business, finance, accounting), letters, civilizations, history, medicine, psychology,...

- •Oral communication (in English or French): Plenary talk: 40 min + 10 min for discussions; Invited talk: 30 min + 10 min for discussions; Regular talk: 20 min + 5 min for discussions
- Posters: AD format is suitable; Dimensions are 150 cm (height) X 90cm (width).

All accepted submissions are included in the workshop proceeding. The authors of relevant submissions will be invited to extend their work to publish on the Asia Pacific Journal on Computational Engineering – APJCEN: http://www.apjcen.com

AWARDS & TRAVEL GRANTS

3 awards for the best oral presentation of 3 tracks: applied science, natural science, social science and 1 award for the best poster will be selected by the scientific committee. Each award includes 150 euros and a certificate. The selection is only applied for participants (except invited speakers) who present their work at the workshop. A limited number of travel grants is available for eligible participants of JRD 2013.
